- Changes to roles and groups are automatically reflected in new meetings.
- Flows can be managed via roles and groups. If users are added to these roles or groups, this has a direct effect on existing Flows.
- When a new meeting is created, the meeting details page is displayed directly without showing the intermediate participant review page.

- **Improved the document collections dialog.**

The dialog for creating and modifying document collections is now more intuitive to use.

- **Introduced a new configurable alert feature for disk-space limits in team data rooms.**

Administrators of Brainloop MeetingSuite can now configure thresholds that trigger the visual indicator in the **Team data rooms** view of the **Administration** and a notification email when pre-defined disk space thresholds are reached. This enables organization administrators to receive timely notifications and to effectively manage storage capacities in team data rooms.

1. To enable the feature for storage thresholds:

Go to **Administration > Policies > Settings** and set the slider next to **Customize storage usage thresholds for team data rooms** to **Activated**.

2. To change the thresholds (in percent):

Select and move the orange slider for warnings and/or the red slider for notifications and select **Save changes**.

**Note:** When the threshold for warnings (orange) is met, the icon in the **Total used column** of the **Team data rooms** tab in **Administration** will turn orange. When the threshold for notifications (red) is met, the same icon will turn red and an email notification will be sent to organization administrators. The amount of used storage space also receives the corresponding color in the menu that is displayed when you select your profile icon in the corresponding data room.

Once the order of the documents has been changed, the browser cache may need to be emptied to see the modification in the document collection.

- **Introduced an alphabetical default order for all documents included in a document collection if no other order is specified.**  
Sorting is based on the folder and file names. Folders are sorted alphabetically first, followed by the documents in the respective folders.

The searching and filter for files, version information or hierarchies works faster now.

- **Introduced the automatic generation of document collections for meeting Flows.**

When a meeting Flow is concluded a document collection with all attached documents is automatically created during the publishing process. Document collections are not automatically generated if the document collection feature is generally deactivated. A notification is displayed if one or several documents can not be included in the document collection.

- **Implemented consent information for sending documents for digital signing (QES).**

Users are fully informed that their documents will leave Brainloop's secure infrastructure and will be transferred to their signature provider before they complete the envelope and send out any documents using qualified electronic signature (QES). Users can confirm or deny their consent and therefore continue or cancel the process, respectively.

## MEETINGSUITE 2.130.15000 | RELEASE NOTES

**This update contains the following bug fix:**

- **Fixed an issue that could lead to an error when the resolution list is accessed.**

When an organization administrator deleted an active Flow via **Administration > Flows > Flows**, Board Officers were no longer able to access the resolution list. An error message and an empty resolution list were displayed instead.

## MEETINGSUITE 2.130.14762 | RELEASE NOTES

**This update contains the following improvements:**

- **Added the vendor Namirial for signing documents digitally.**

The qualified electronic signature (QES) functionality controls the digital signing of documents through a third-party signature vendor. Customers who want to use the feature require an account with DocuSign or Namirial. They should also be aware that documents will be transferred to the vendor of choice for the signing process.

- QES is available for team data rooms, once the feature has been activated and set up for the team data room.
- Users with **Request signatures** permissions can send documents with signature requests to other organization members.
- Members of the organization can then sign documents digitally in a legally binding manner via DocuSign or Namirial.
- **Introduced options to download documents with and without watermark from personal data rooms and team data rooms.**

Users can select the more options icon next to the file and choose **Download original** or **Download with watermark**. Options can be restricted by data room managers.

- **Improved warning labels if few or no licenses for the organization are available.**

The warning labels appear in the **Users view** and the **Add user** dialog if 80 percent or more of the available licenses are in use.

**This update closes the following vulnerabilities:**

- **Fixed an issue that could allow users without proper authorization to access and manage filters for Flows.**

**This update provides the following bug fixes:**

- **Fixed an issue with the display of Flow titles that are too long by introducing a tooltip that shows the whole Flow title.**
- **Fixed an issue that could prevent a board officer from finalizing an application Flow.**

## MEETINGSUITE 2.125.8000 | RELEASE NOTES

**This update contains the following improvements:**

- **Introduced creating and printing of document collections.**

Several documents can be combined in a collection and printed collectively using the print functionality. An option to save the document collection locally as a PDF file is available via the printer settings.

- **Introduced date-based removal of team data room members.**

During the invitation of new members and in the properties of existing members, data room managers can set a date, when this member is automatically removed from the team data room.

- **Introduced admin history reports for Flows.**

Organization administrators can create history reports for the Flows of an organization. The report is generated as a CSV file and saved to the administrator's personal data room.

- **Improved security with OpenID Connect (OIDC).**

Whenever the OIDC server configuration changes, users need to confirm the new configuration before they can log into MeetingSuite.

The new qualified electronic signature (QES) functionality controls the digital signing of documents through a third-party signature vendor, i.e. DocuSign. Customers who want to use the feature require an account with DocuSign. They should also be aware that documents will be transferred to DocuSign for the signing process.

- QES is available for team data rooms, once the feature has been activated and set up for the team data room.
- Dataroom users with Request signatures permissions can send documents with signature requests to other organization members.
- Members of the organization can then sign documents digitally in a legally binding manner (via DocuSign).

- **Introduced new “E-signature” option for team data rooms with QES.**

The new **E-signature** menu in the team data room navigation on the left displays a list of items with signature requests (**Envelopes**) and their status as well as the **Configuration** menu.

Activities and events in MeetingSuite are tracked and logged to safeguard the application and to allow for the monitoring of actions. The entire QES process - from initiating a signature request to the signing and storing of the item to a selected target folder - is logged and can be viewed via the item history.

- **Introduced multiple decision lanes for MeetingSuite Flows.**

In a corporate context, multiple stakeholders often need to vote on partial aspects of a topic before a final decision can be made to approve or reject the issue as a whole.

Previously, application management Flows were able to manage one vote - either through a circular resolution or by handing the task over to the Meeting Flow.

With the new MeetingSuite version, application management Flows can be set up to handle multiple decisions by introducing so-called (decision) lanes. All lanes work as separate circular resolutions inside the application management Flow. Each lane represents a vote/decision in the topic.

Thanks to this concept, stakeholders can vote on different aspects of an issue in one application. These individual decisions are summarized in one document as soon as the final decision has been made.

- **Setting up multiple lanes for an application management Flow:**

1. In the **Configure the Flow dialog**, select the option **Edit as JSON** in the top-right corner.
2. Scroll down until you reach the section called “lanes”: 1,
3. Change the number of decision lanes you want to use with this application management Flow.  
Tip: Ideally, add the number of lanes to the Flow name for easier recognition, e.g. Multi-lane application 3.

- **Continued adjustment of MeetingSuite to comply with GDPR requirements.**

- **Introduced an error message for missing information when creating a data room.**

When attempting to save a newly created team data room and information is missing or incorrect, such as an email address or the data room manager, users now receive an informative message.

- **Fixed an issue with trailing and leading spaces in templates that interfered with the synchronization of Flows.**

When users create or modify Flow configurations and save the configuration, the system now automatically removes trailing and leading spaces.
